To provide quality construction services at competitive rates while honoring Jesus Christ in our approach to diligently serve our clients in attaining their goals and aspirations.

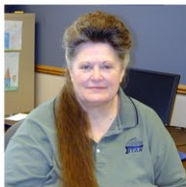
Project Highlights

Top Ten Red Cross Cold Weather Safety Tips

- 1 **Layer up!** Wear layers of lightweight clothing to stay warm.
- 2 **Don't forget your furry friends.** Bring pets indoors or make sure they have enough shelter and unfrozen water.
- 3 **Remember the three feet rule.** If you are using a space heater keep anything flammable at least three feet away..
- 4 **Requires supervision** – Turn off space heaters and make sure fireplace embers are out before leaving the room.
- 5 **Don't catch fire!** If you are using a fireplace, use a fire screen large enough to catch sparks and rolling logs.
- 6 **Protect your pipes.** Run water, even at a trickle, to help prevent your pipes from freezing and open cabinet doors to allow warmer air to circulate around the plumbing.
- 7 **Better safe than sorry.** Keep the thermostat at the same temperature day and night. Your heating bill may be a little higher, but you could avoid a more costly repair job if your pipes freeze and burst.
- 8 **The kitchen is for cooking.** Never use a stove or oven to heat your home.
- 9 **Use generators outside.** Never operate a generator inside the home, including in the basement or garage.
- 10 **Knowledge is power.** Don't hook a generator up to the home's wiring without a proper transfer switch.
