To provide quality construction services at competitive rates while honoring Jesus Christ in our approach to diligently serve our clients in attaining their goals and aspirations.

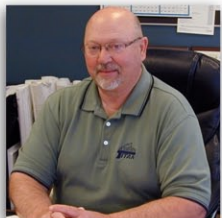
Project Highlights

Construction will start in July for the new “Northend Community Center” in the area of the Market Square Mall in Lafayette. Titan Construction and Engineering is fortunate to be serving as the overall Design-Build General Contractor for this project. This 95,000sf community center was designed to offer assistance and outreach to the Northend residents of Lafayette and will house many established local not-for-profit organization to accomplish this mission. The facility will be complete with amenities such as (2) basketball courts for leagues, a swimming pool

to cater to the young and elderly, fitness center with exercise rooms, indoor walking track, meeting/gathering spaces for groups and organizations to use, and an in-house restaurant serving sandwiches and bakery items. Also on site will be a soccer field offering youth and adult leagues, a separate facility for short-term homeless families, and a low-cost auto repair center focused on assisting single moms, veterans, and seniors. The complex is scheduled to be completed in the late summer of 2018.

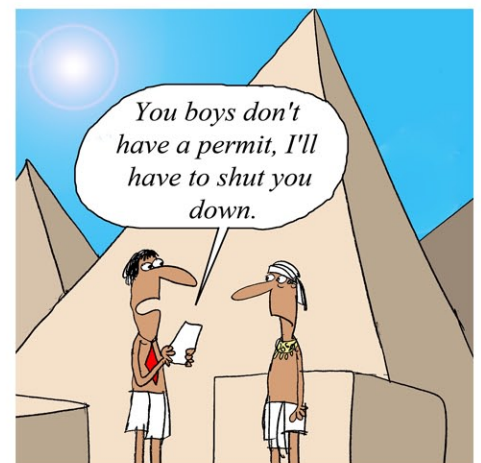
